

Overview of Airlines in Vietnam




Number of Aircraft

In 2035: 547 aircrafts in Vietnam (growth rate: 13.3%/year)

IATA forecasts five fastest growing markets in additional passengers (2015-2035)

China: 817 million new passengers for a total of 1.3 billion

US: 484 million new passengers for a total of 1.1 billion


INDIA: 332 million new passengers for a total of 442 million

INDONESIA: 135 million new passengers for a total of 242 million

VIETNAM: 112 million new passengers for a total of 150 million


Global MRO Spend in 2019 – 2033, \$B


Overview of MRO industry in Vietnam Vie



Global MRO demand 2023 is \$94B (98% of 2019)

- □ South East Asia: \$5.04 billion 2,250 aircrafts in 2023
- Vietnam: \$610 million 207 aircrafts in 2023

Overview of MRO industry in Vietnam

- Integrated MRO: VAECO, VSAE
- MRO (line maintenance): SAMM
- MRO (component maintenance): AESC, VSTEA
- Part M Maintenance: Pacific Airlines, Vietjet, Bamboo Airways
- Total workforce in aircraft maintenance in 2023: 4,784 staff
- Total revenues from MRO (excluding Part M): \$91 millions in 2023
- Total revenues from MRO (including Part M): \$112 millions
- Total value of MRO in Vietnam in 2023: 610 millions of USD
- Outsourcing: 75%

□ Opportunities

- High growth of aviation market with 12% in next 10 years
- New airports constructed (Long Thanh Airport) and expansion of major airports (Tan Son Nhat Airport, Noi Bai Airport, Da Nang Airport) in the coming years
- High rate of maintenance outsourcing of airlines in Vietnam
- MRO demand in 2030 is 1.51 billions of USD
- Labor force with good skills and low pay
- Vietnam will have 28 domestic and international airports nation wide by 2030
- Aviation hub in region with 34 millions of international passenger in 2023 of 80 millions of passengers in total, and 1.23 million tons of international goods of 1.44 million tons of goods



□ Challenges

- Shortage of mechanics and certifying staffs
- Lack of preferential policy from government to support MRO industry
- Shortage of hangar
- Weak supporting industry for MRO
- Lack of distribution hub for materials and spare parts of aircraft






MRO Staff Salaries




Salary	Singapore	Vietnam
School leavers	1,000 - 1,200 USD/month	300 - 350 USD/month
Skilled Engineer (min 5 years of experiences)	2,500 - 3,500 USD/month	2,000 - 3,000 USD/month
Managerial Manpower	10,000 - 15,000 USD/month	6,000 - 10,000 USD/month


Solutions to improve the outsourcing rate of MRO in Vietnam

- □ Vietnam needs to attract more manufacturers, OEM to open the manufacturing facilities in Vietnam.
- ☐ Engine shop, APU shop, landing gear shop have to be established in Vietnam
- □ Vietnam needs to allow the tearing down aircraft to be developed in Vietnam
- □ Vietnam has to build more wide body hangar to meet the demand of hangars for C check.

Maintenance Costs Optimization in Vietnam

- In house training for mechanics to become licensing engineer
- Arranging reasonable roster and controlling overtime payment for mechanics
- Setting up cost base system to monitor aircraft component repair, engine maintenance, and heavy airframe maintenance especially end of lease check
- Minimizing spare parts and consumables stock level
- Combining between airlines and independent MRO to do C check
- Sharing the resources of consumables and tools among airlines and MROs
- Performing A checks, phase check at night time
- Outsourcing complete maintenance services to MRO for start up airlines
